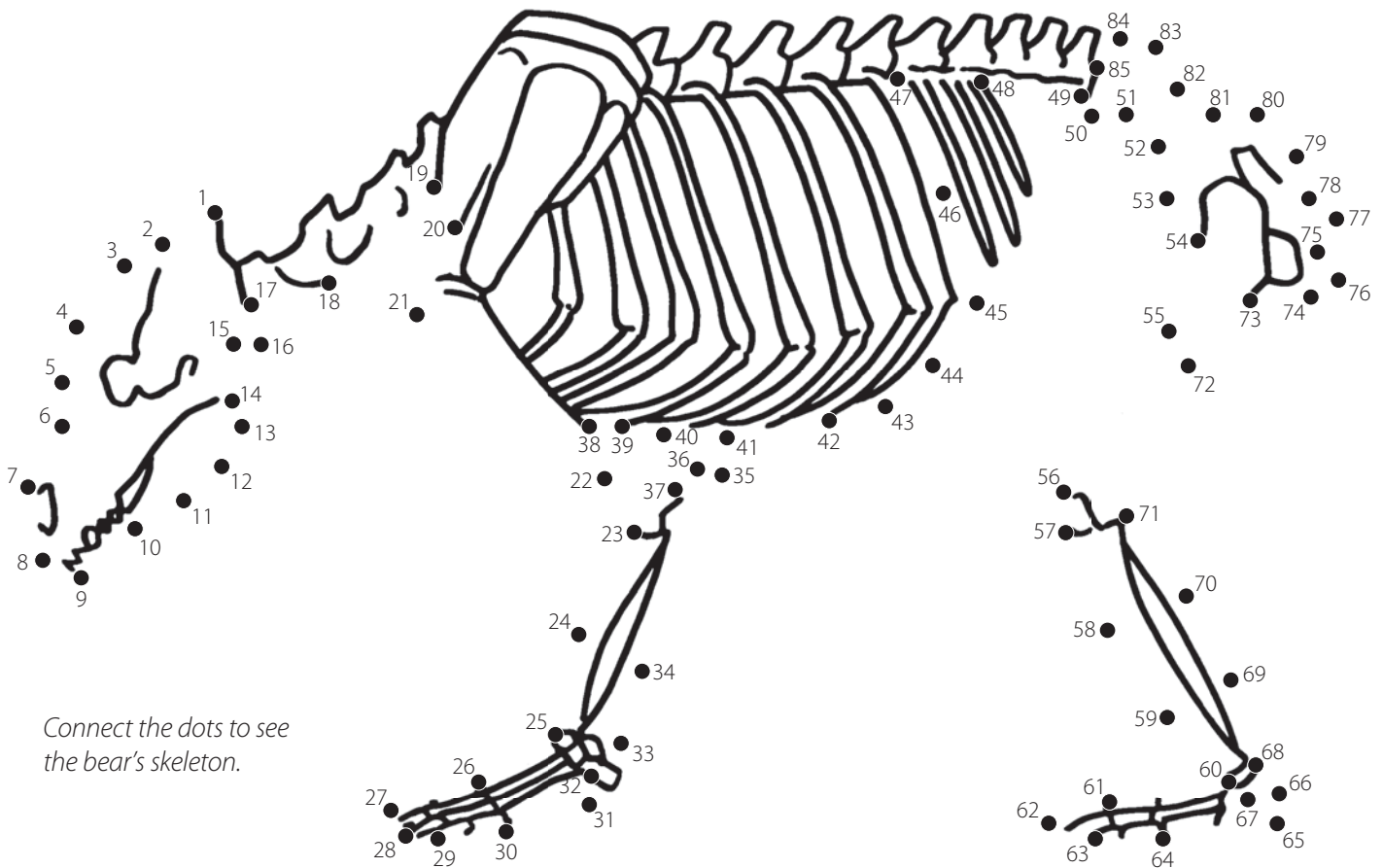

Black Bear

Most black bears are dark in color, but they can also be light brown, light gray, and even blonde. Bears can live in a wide range of habitats, including forests, mountains, and deserts.

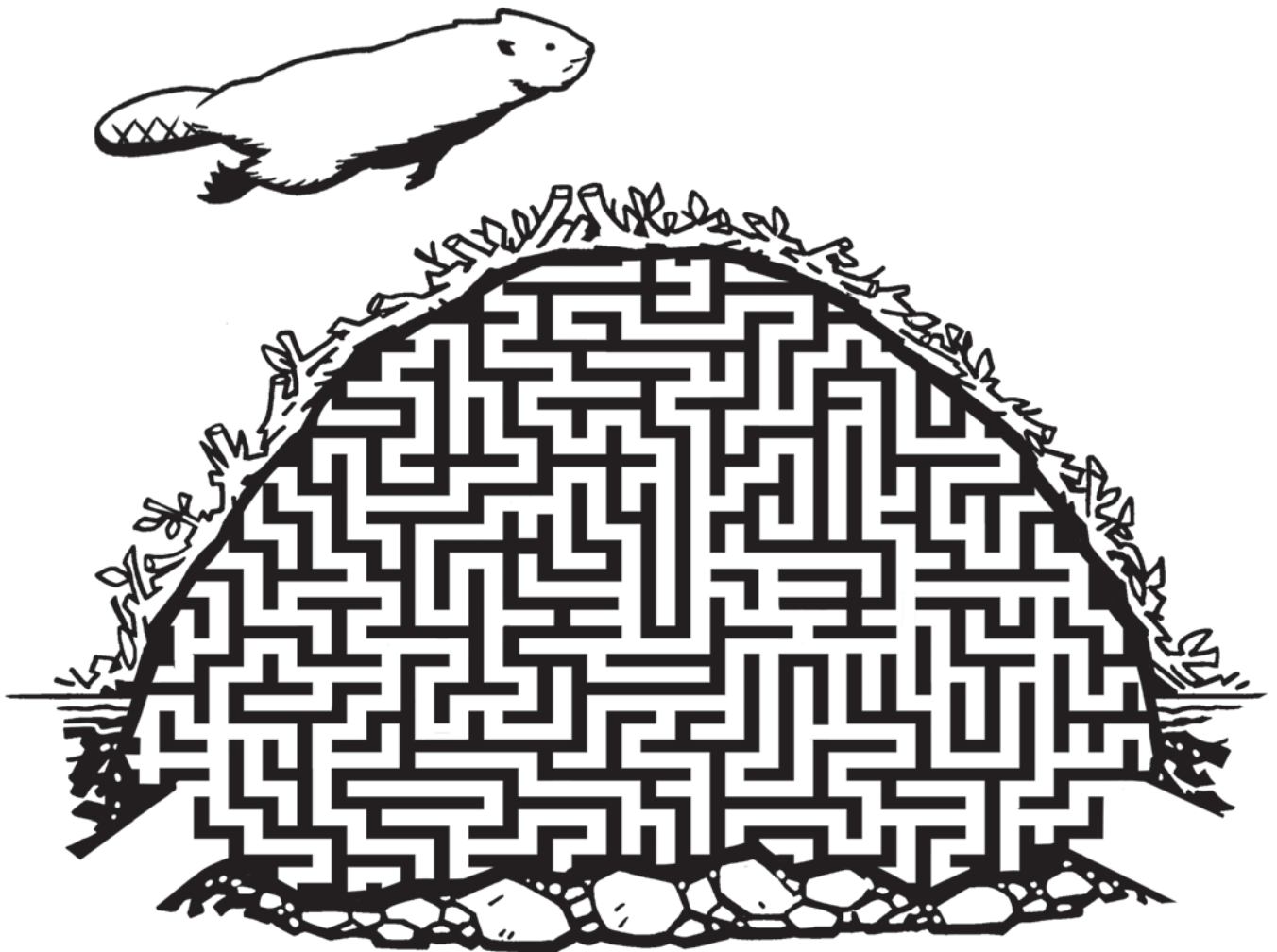

Beavers live inside the dams they build, and their dams have more than one way in and out. Help the beaver find its way through the maze below.



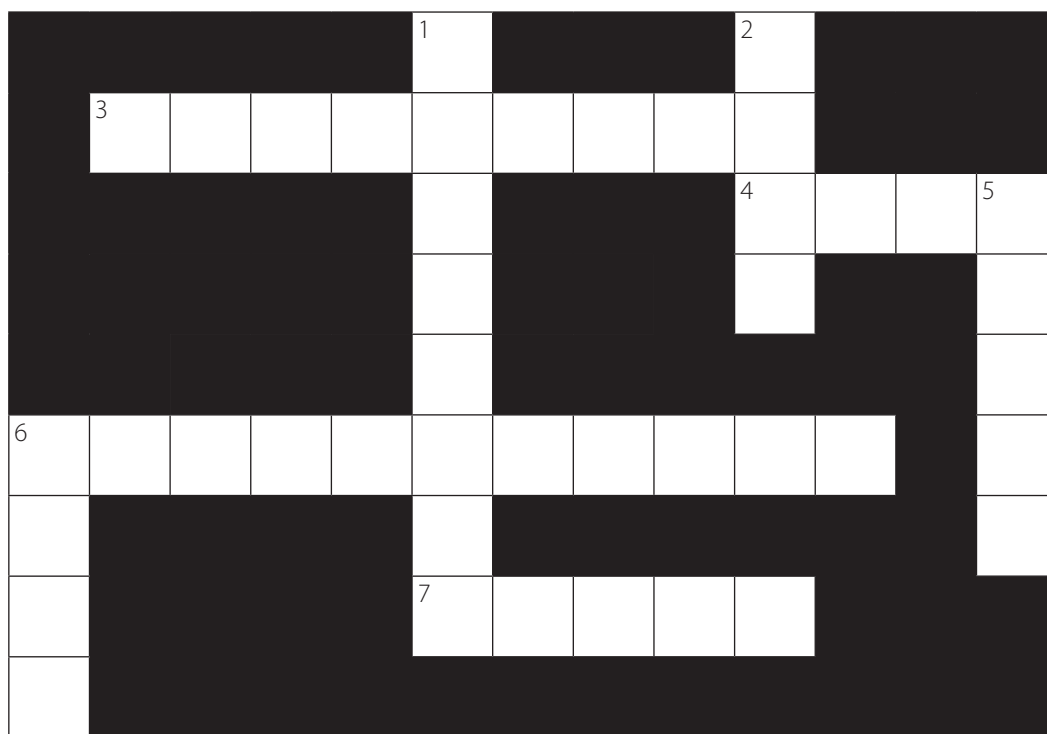

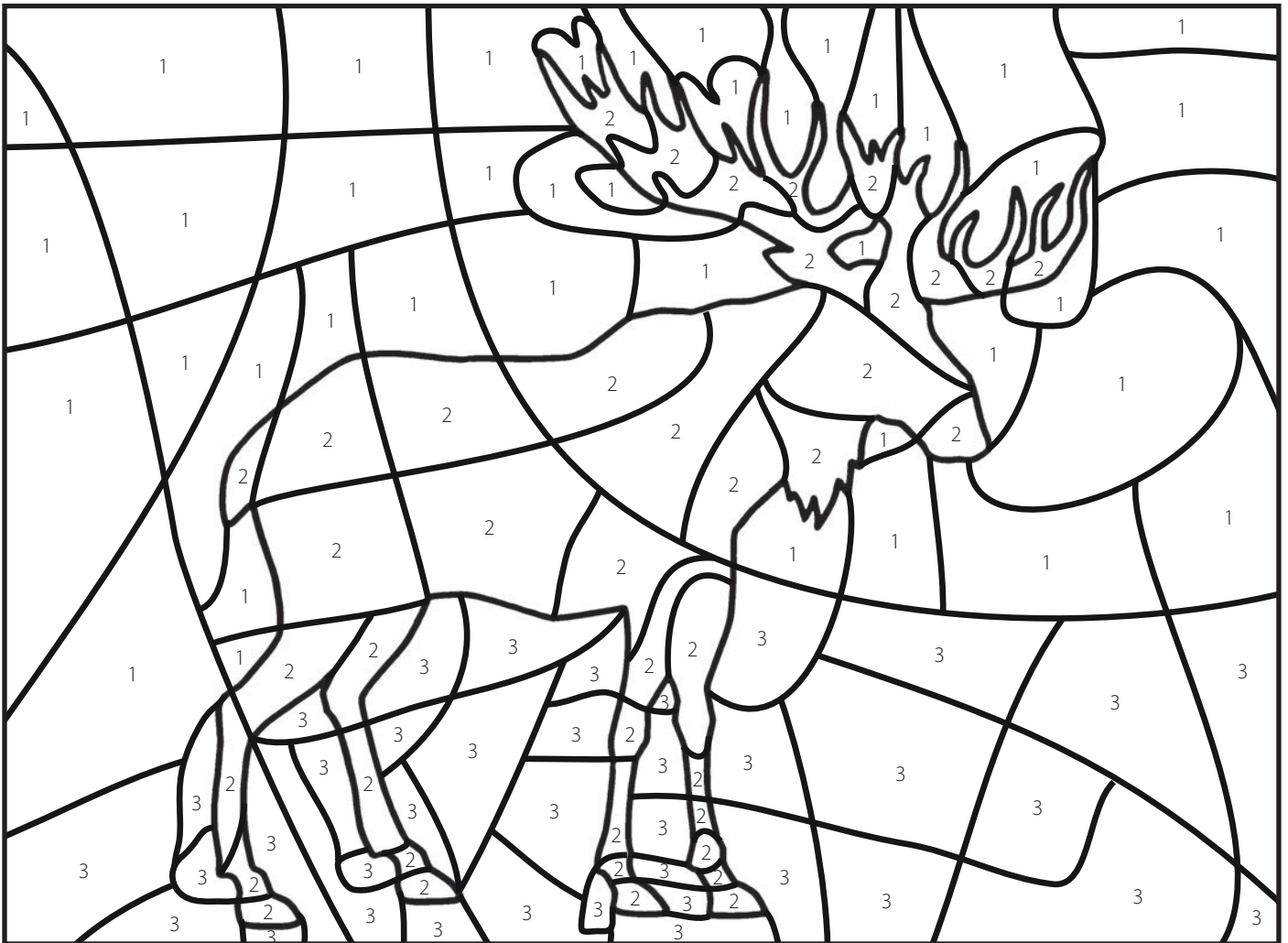
