## Blue Jay

Blue Jays live year-round in the eastern half of the United States. They are easy to recognize by the spiky crest on their heads, the bright-blue and black feathers on their backs and wings, and their white bellies. These large, noisy, intelligent birds can feed on almost anything that other birds eat, and they like to visit bird feeders.
