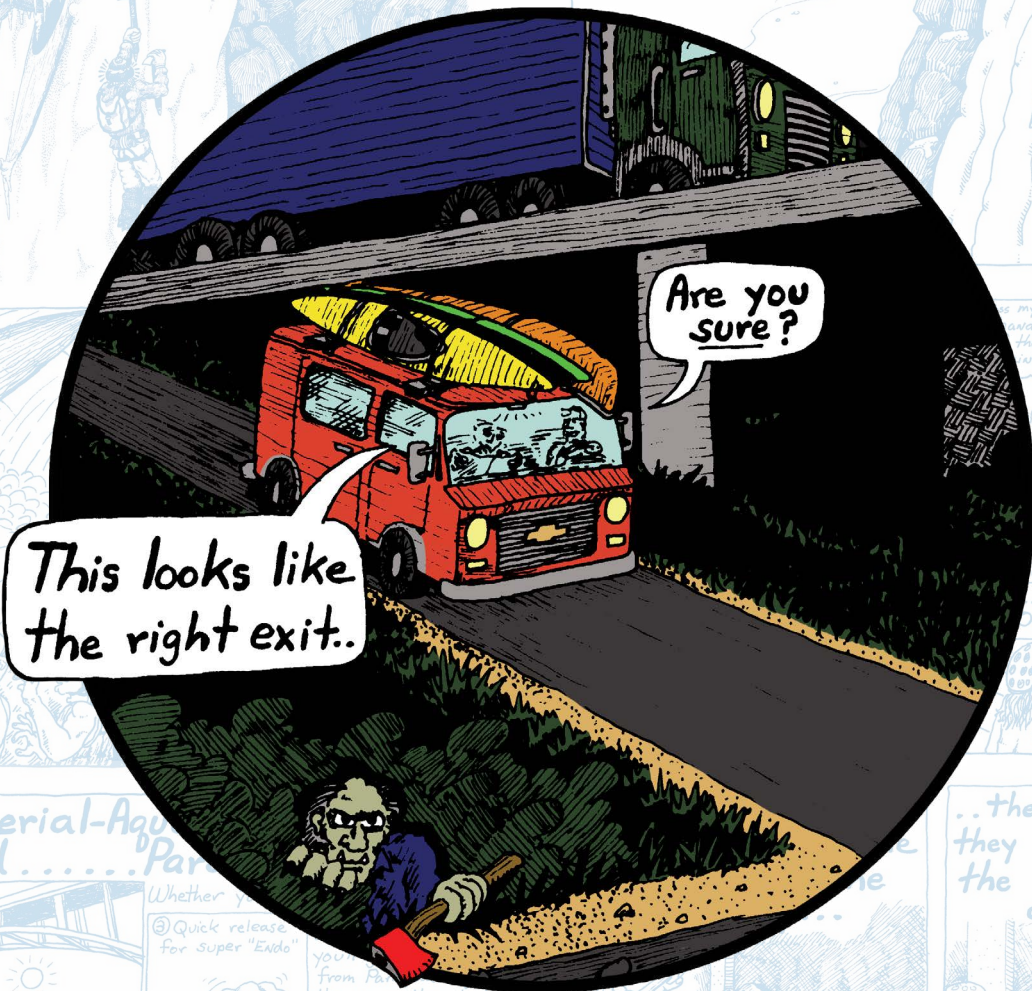

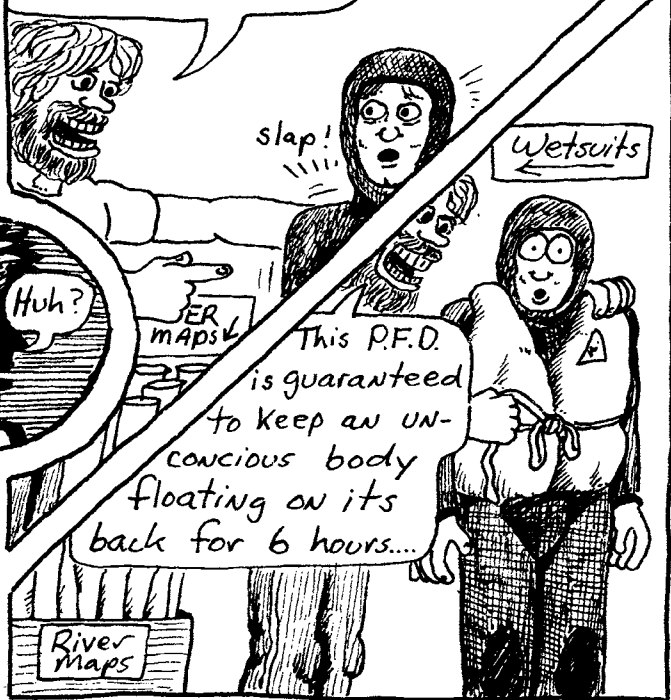

Better get a real good helmet so's you don't splatter your brains on a rock when you flip over in a rapid.

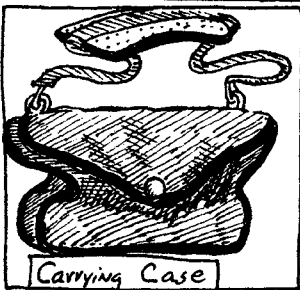
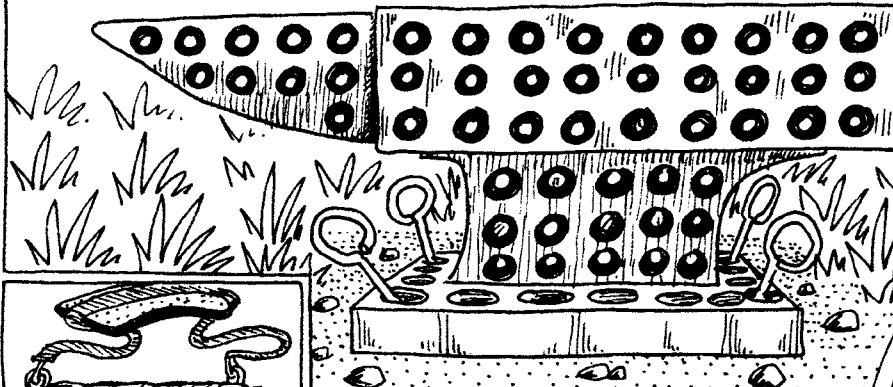

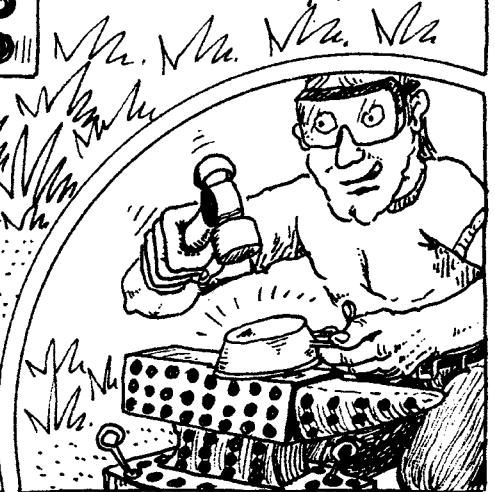
Ultra-lightweight Anvil makes backcountry metalworking a snap!

Seventy lightening holes and all aluminum construction reduces weight drastically!



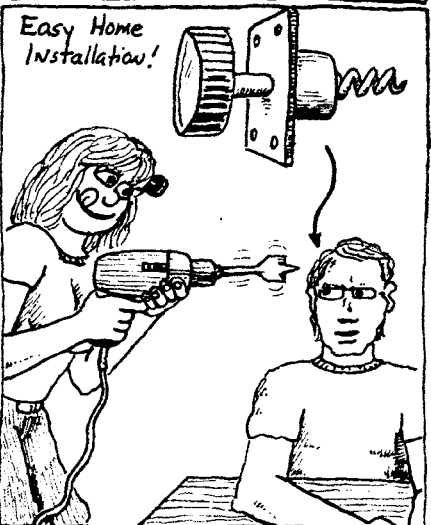

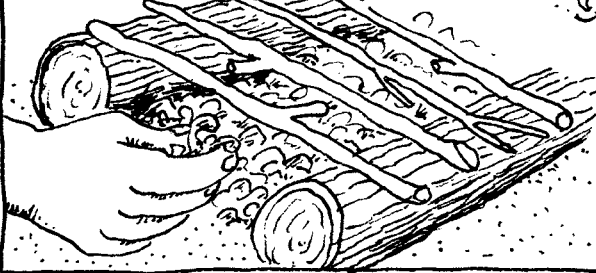
How to start a fire with wet wood...

1. Begin with a properly oriented foundation



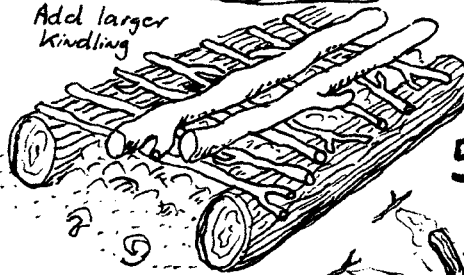
Place small sticks evenly spaced across base logs

Add larger kindling



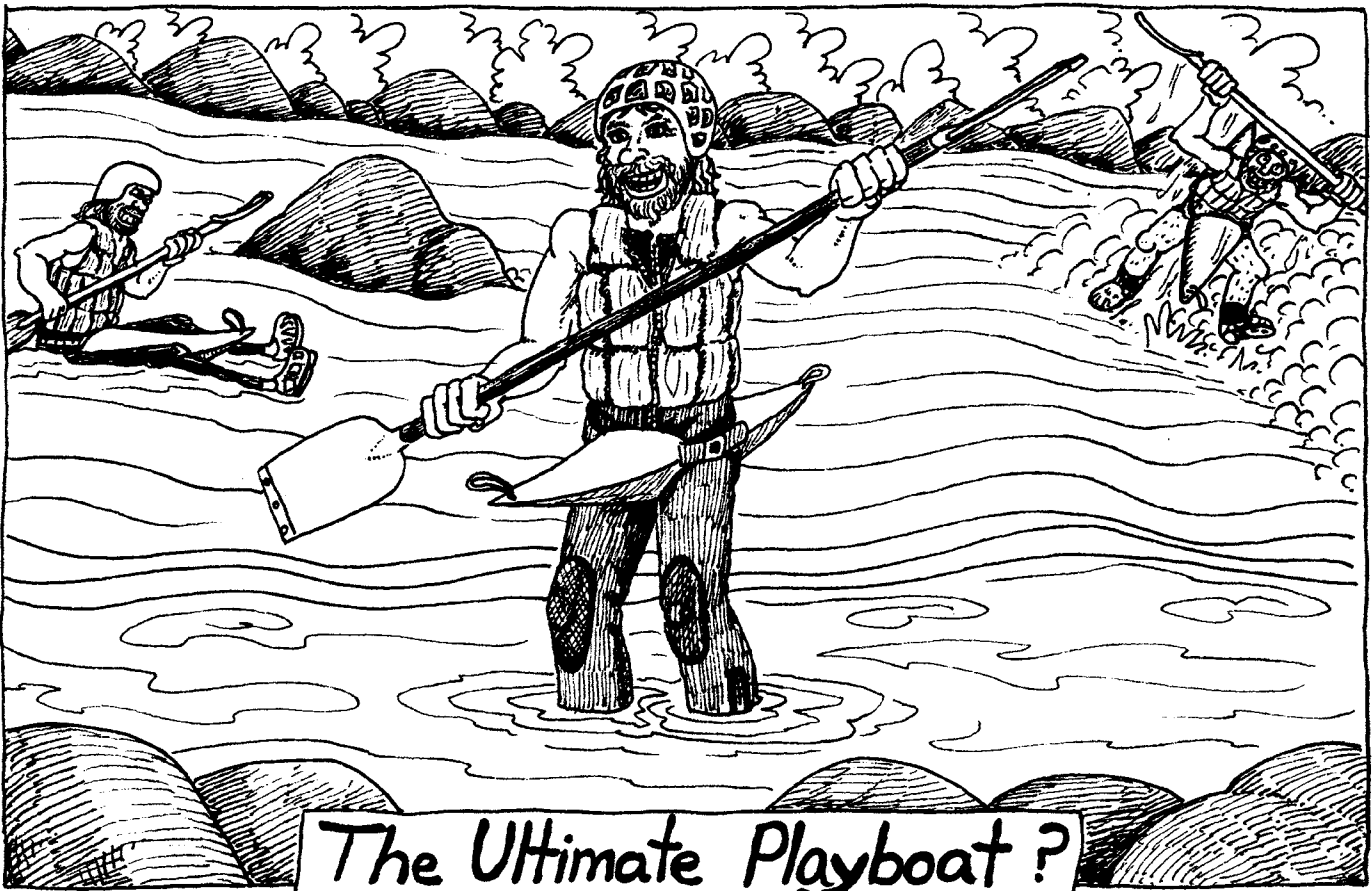
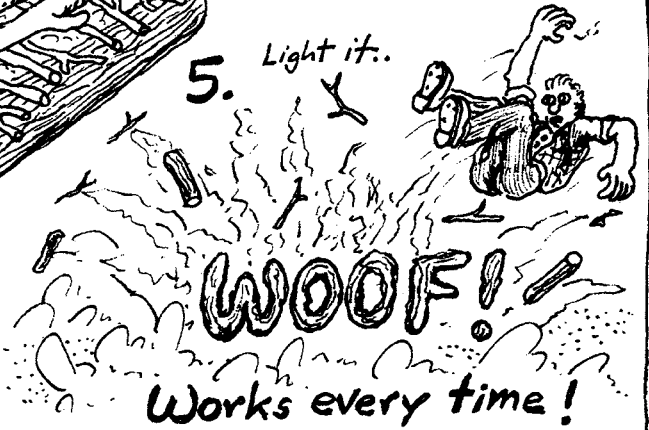

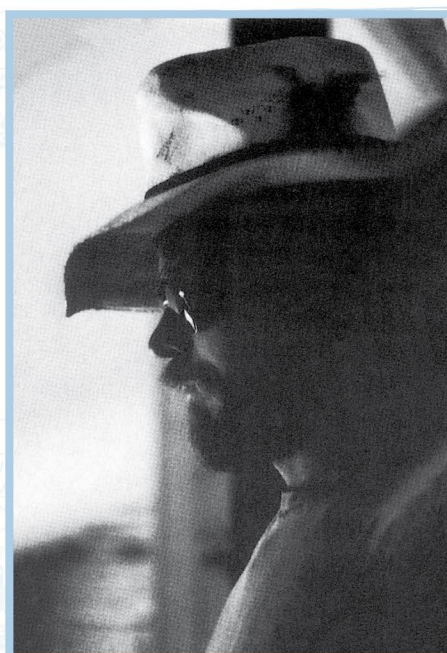
